**Note: the fees are always by the year the player was born in. Families with 2 siblings registering can deduct an additional \$50. Families with 3 or more siblings pay the regular fee(s) for the oldest 2 then ½ the fee for the youngest child. Families with 4 or more siblings will need to email or call for the fee structure. Families with siblings who are new to hockey need not wait; the sibling can be registered now-see the website for “New Player” Registration. Registrations for New players (never played before) and live within our boundary will be accepted June 1<sup>st</sup> 2010. Please see the website for New Player forms and requirements.**



FOR PEEWEE, BANTAM, MIDGET & JUVENILE YOU MUST MARK HITTING OR NO HITTING ON YOUR REGISTRATION FORM – IF NO INDICATION IS GIVEN ON VMHA WILL PLACE YOU.....GOALIES MUST ALSO INDICATE IF HAVE THEIR OWN EQUIPMENT (OR NOT). FIRST TIME REGISTRANTS CANNOT PLAY GOAL IN THEIR FIRST YEAR – THEY MUST PLAY OUT AS A “REGULAR” PLAYER.

A couple of things to be aware of; registrants are not guaranteed a space until our ice allocation is finalized and coaches are placed and confirmed. Once these are in place (early to mid-August), we will have association managers calling you with the assessment schedule. As well, the Ice schedule is **NOT** available until the season starts; do not call or email for hockey schedule. We simply do not have that information. You will be given schedules and locations by the Team or Division Manager as the teams are formed.



**Payments by Credit Card:** This year you can pay by credit card – login details will be provided separately. When this is ready to go, the link will be posted on our website. You will still be required to submit signed dated registration forms and payment by cheque or money order remains an option. Retain your online registration and payment receipt. Your Hockey ID is in the upper right hand corner of the returning player form (under the bar code) as well; it is shown on the receipt.



**Code of Conduct:** All players and Parents will be required to sign a Code of Conduct Agreement for the 2010-2011 Hockey Season. After player assessments have been completed and the players have been assigned their respective teams the Team Manager or Coach will hand out the required forms. Complete and return to the Team Manager– these forms will be retained by the Association.

- Cheques remain an option, however you are not considered “registered” until the cheque has been received and processed (made payable to: Vancouver Minor Hockey Association OR VMHA)
  - NSF or returned cheques will be subject to a \$25 charge (per cheque) including Tournament payments
