Daktronics – All Sport 5000 Series

Common Code: 4402 – Hockey with shots on goal (SOG)

Common Code: 4401 – Hockey without shots on goal (SOG)

SETTING UP PRE-GAME – 5 MINUTES WARM-UP TIME:

Press MENU
Press ENTER/YES
Press SET MAIN CLOCK
Press 5:00
Press ENTER/YES
Press START (*when both teams on ice*)

SETTING PERIOD TIMES:

Press PERIOD +1
Press SET MAIN CLOCK
Press 15:00
Press ENTER/YES
(*Referee will advise the 3rd period time*)

SETTING SCORES – EITHER HOME OR GUEST TEAM:

Press SCORE + 1
Press SCORE - 1

SETTING PENALTIES – EITHER HOME OR GUEST TEAM:

Press PLAYER PENALTY
Press PLAYER'S JERSEY NUMBER (e.g. 13)
Press ENTER/YES
Press ENTER YES to automatically set 2:00 minute minor penalty

To enter a double minor (4:00) or major (5:00)

Press PLAYER PENALTY
Press PLAYER'S JERSEY NUMBER (e.g. 13)
Press ENTER/YES
Press PENALTY MINUTES (e.g. 4:00 or 5:00)
Press ENTER/YES

(a third penalty will not display on the scoreboard. The 2:00 minutes will not start until the first player's penalty has terminated)

DELETING PENALTY TIME HOME OR GUEST TEAM:

Press DELETE PENALTY
Press ENTER/YES

RE-SETTING CLOCK BACK TO NORMAL AFTER GAME:

Press MENU
Press ^ (*above Menu*)
Follow instructions and answer questions on the screen; enter the current time.

SECTION G - GAME TIMES AND SCHEDULES

(for Atom level and above – refer to Section R for Novice levels)

7. All league and playoff games shall be in accordance with the following schedule as it fits available ice time. This must be noted on the game report. Notwithstanding any additional ice time, the maximum game time shall be three 20-minute stoppage periods.

(*)-Applicable to the PeeWee, Bantam, Midget, and Juvenile divisions only.

No rates in excess of the above schedule shall be permitted (including all exhibition, league, playoff, and tournament / jamboree games).

- (b) Where fewer than the required number of on-ice officials appear for a game, those official(s) in attendance shall be paid a single referee's expense allowance.
- (c) When and where referees are used for inter-Association games in the Tyke division, they shall be paid the same expense allowance as the Novice division.
