

Britannia / 8-Rinks – Score Clock Instructions

Turning On the Clock

1. It will ask you: “Do you want to start where you left off last?” – Press **NO**
2. Enter Model Code of machine – Enter **008-3261** (could be 871) and Press **NO**
3. “Do you want Penalty Time Out?” – Press **YES**

Setting Time

1. Press **SET** button
2. Press **TIME** button
3. Enter time **5:00** for warm-up and **15:00** for periods, etc. (3rd period is half of ice time remaining)
4. Press **YES**
5. It will ask for the period: Press **0 (zero) 1, 2 or 3**

Starting and Stopping Time

1. It will either have an **ON TIME** and **OFF TIME** button on the bottom left or the clock OR
2. It will have a toggle **ON/OFF** switch at the top left
3. Make sure you hit the **OFF** switch/button at the end of every period or it will keep buzzing

Setting the Score / Adding Goals

1. *At the beginning of the game:*
 - a. Press **SET**
 - b. Press **HOME SCORE**
 - c. Press **0**
 - d. Press **SET**
 - e. Press **GUEST SCORE**
 - f. Press **0**
2. *During the game:*
 - a. Press **HOME SCORE** or **GUEST SCORE**
 - b. Press **1, 2, 3**, etc.
 - c. Then press **YES/TIME** and it will take you back to the time screen

If you make a mistake and add the score to the wrong team, just use Step 1 to fix it, and press the correct number of goals for each team.

Penalties:

1. *Adding a Penalty*
 - a. Press **SET**
 - b. Press **HOME PNLTY** or **GUEST PNLTY**
 - c. Enter penalty time (usually **2:00, 4:00** or **5:00**)
 - d. Press **YES**
 - e. Enter **Player Number** (must be 2 digits – **02** or **13**)
2. *Clearing a Penalty (if a goal is scored on the power play)*
 - a. Press **HOME PNLTY** or **GUEST PNLTY**
 - b. Press **PNLTY CLEAR**
 - c. Press **YES**

Please note: Do not enter penalties if a player from both teams receives off-setting penalties. The players will exit the box at the next whistle after their penalty is over. The start time is tracked by the Scorekeeper.

SECTION G - GAME TIMES AND SCHEDULES (for Atom level and above – refer to Section R for Novice levels)

7. All league and playoff games shall be in accordance with the following schedule as it fits available ice time. This must be noted on the game report. Notwithstanding any additional ice time, the maximum game time shall be three 20-minute stoppage periods.

SECTION I - REFEREES AND LINESMEN

8. (a) Referee and linesmen expense allowances for all games within the PCAHA shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

Ice times of 2 hours and greater \$6.00 / \$6.00 / \$6.00 (*) (additional allowance)

Ice times of 2½ hours and greater \$9.00 / \$9.00 / \$9.00 (*) (additional allowance)

(*)-Applicable to the PeeWee, Bantam, Midget, and Juvenile divisions only.

No rates in excess of the above schedule shall be permitted (including all exhibition, league, playoff, and tournament / jamboree games).

- (b) Where fewer than the required number of on-ice officials appear for a game, those official(s) in attendance shall be paid a single referee's expense allowance.
- (c) When and where referees are used for inter-Association games in the Tyke division, they shall be paid the same expense allowance as the Novice division.
