

PNE Agrodome 2901 East Hastings St.

Health Check

VMHA members must **complete the TeamSnap Health Check PRIOR to arrival at the arena**. Health Check can be found in Event Details and is available 8 hours before the event.

A designated team official will check participants in and confirm the Health Check has been completed. Individuals will not be permitted to enter the building if the Health Check is incomplete/failed.

Entrance/Timing

Please arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to your ice time. Players may wait in the tented area (physically distanced, masks on) until their group is ready to enter the facility.

Players and designated team officials will be allowed into the building, as a group, **5 minutes** before ice time. **No spectators are permitted.**

Masks are required. Players may remove their masks once they have reached their respective benches. Off-ice, participants must wear masks at all times while in the building.

Enter the PNE grounds through Gate 6 (Renfrew St.). The Drop-off Zone will be on the north side of the Agrodome, opposite Hastings Park Racetrack. Players (U13 and above) should be dropped off at the entrance to the parking lot to avoid congestion in the area. Parking is available at Gate 6 should parents wish to remain on the PNE grounds.

Practices

Dressing areas will NOT be used, please arrive at the rink mostly dressed. Players may use the folding chairs at the south end of the rink to put on skates, helmets & gloves. Goalies are permitted to put their pads on in this area as well.

With the exception of goaltenders, hockey bags are not permitted in the building. Players should bring a small bag for their belongings, water bottle, skate guards, shoes, mask, etc.

Players will take all their personal belongings with them to the bench and deposit them in the marked "Bag Drop" areas. A team official will need to move the goaltenders' bags to the bench.

At the end of the session, players will collect their bags and proceed to the folding chairs at the north end of the arena. **Participants will put on their masks immediately. Players have TEN (10) MINUTES to** remove the minimum amount of equipment required to **exit the arena** (skates, helmets & gloves, goalie pads).

Water stations are NOT available. Please fill your bottles before leaving for the rink.

No off-ice activities (dry-land/warm-up/stretching) are permitted inside the building.

<u>Games</u>

Dressing areas are not used. Water stations are NOT available.

No off-ice activities (dry-land/warm-up/stretching) are not permitted inside the building.

Players* on BOTH teams arrive COMPLETELY dressed (skates & guards, helmets, AND masks).

With the exception of goaltenders, hockey bags are not permitted. It is recommended that players bring a small bag to hold their water bottle, skate guards, masks, etc.

*Goaltenders from both teams may arrive partially dressed and will be allowed to enter a few minutes early to put on their skates and pads. Please use the folding chairs at the south end of the rink. Coaches and officials (referees/linesmen) are also permitted to use this area. A team official will need to move the goaltenders' bags to the bench.

Teams will proceed to the ice surface entrance immediately upon entering the facility and may cross the ice to their respective benches upon direction from the officials. Masks are to be worn until players arrive at the bench.

At the end of the game, players will return to the bench, put on their masks and skate guards, and exit the facility immediately. Goaltenders are permitted to use the folding chairs at the north end of the rink to remove pads & skates before leaving.

Arena exit is at the north end of the rink and is accessible via the walkway behind the players benches.

Additional Information

PNE arena capacity (games) is 48 participants: players, team officials, referees/linesmen, score & time-keepers only. NO SPECTATORS.

Arena seating is not to be used by team officials

VMHA teams using the Agrodome will be provided with badges to identify volunteers permitted to be in the building (coaches/manager/HCSPs) as well as extras for time/scorekeepers when needed. These badges will need to be presented to the rink attendant upon entry.
