VMHA Jersey Care Policy

(last updated: July 2021)

VMHA would like all of its players to enjoy and wear their VMHA hockey jerseys with pride. Our game jerseys are re-used each year and replaced when their lifespan is up to keep player costs in check. In order for every player to enjoy their experience please ensure you follow our policies on wear and care.

<u>Jersey Wear & Care</u>

- Jerseys are to be worn for games only, not practices.
- Please ensure jerseys are washed regularly and hung to dry (no dryer). White jerseys are especially prone to puck/stick marks and should be washed after EVERY wear.
- Jerseys should be stored hanging up and not in a player's bag.
- No name bars, tape or adhesive of any kind should be attached to the jerseys. Only Cs and As are permitted hand stitched on jerseys. (applies to U11 and above).
- In the event a jersey is lost or stolen, please advise equipment@vmha.com ASAP

<u>Jersey Return</u>

- Jerseys should be returned in the condition they were received; clean, dry and hanging in the garment bags provided. (Please ensure that any marks or stains are pre-treated and removed prior to returning).
- Any Cs or As to be carefully removed prior to returning your jersey.

Jersey Deposit Forfeit

- If a jersey is lost and/or not returned at the end of the season you will forfeit your jersey deposit in order to cover the replacement cost.
- If a jersey is returned with damage due to neglect (i.e mould, excessively dirty) you will forfeit your jersey deposit in order to cover the replacement cost.
