

**On Monday, we will be checking for proof of vaccination & here's what you'll need for your next visit.**

Your safety has always been our top priority at Canlan Sports, and we remain committed to supporting the Province of British Columbia as it implements its COVID-19 proof of vaccination requirements.

You have questions, and we want to provide the answers and clarity to ensure your next sports experience is efficient and safe.

**Here's everything you'll need to know on our proof of vaccination requirements, and how to be fully prepared for your next visit:**

**Q: On what date do I need to show my proof of vaccination?**

**A:** By the order of the Provincial Health Officer on August 24, proof of vaccination will be required to enter Canlan Sports & Scotia Barn, starting Monday, September 13.

**Q: Do I need to be fully vaccinated by September 13?**

**A:** At minimum, you'll need to show proof of your first vaccination dose by Monday, September 13.

**Q: When do I need to be fully vaccinated to continue to participate at Canlan Sports & Scotia Barn?**

**A:** You must have your second vaccination dose by October 24.

**Q: Are adults and youth required to show proof of vaccination?**

**A:** The requirement applies to all people born in 2009 or earlier (12 years+)

**Q: Do I need to provide proof of vaccination to play in adult recreational sport?**

**A:** Yes, this requirement is in place for adult recreational sports leagues across the Province.

**Q: Are there any exemptions for Youth Sports?**

**A:** Yes, there are. The Government of British Columbia order states those under the age of 19 do not need to be vaccinated to participate in sport activities at Canlan Sports & Scotia Barn. However, if any youth (12+) chooses to dine-in our restaurant, they must show proof of vaccination. The youth exemption only applies to participation in sporting activities.

**Q: Are there any other exemptions publicized by the province?**

**A:** The Ministry of health is allowing an exemption process in place for extremely rare circumstances, involving a person's doctor and the Office of the Provincial Health Officer. At this point, there are no additional exemptions in place from the Province.

**Q: What is considered "Proof of Vaccination"?**

**A:** From September 13 to September 26, along with a government-issued photo ID, we will accept the following as proof of vaccination:

- Wallet-sized immunization record card (given out at vaccine clinics)
- Printed immunization record from Health Gateway
- Immunization record from your pharmacy (AstraZeneca/SII COVISHIELD)
- National Defence Canada COVID-19 vaccine record or card
- Provincial Immunization Registry record (used by Interior Health and others)
- ImmunizeBC record (used by First Nations Health Authority and others)
- Health authority immunization records: Fraser Health, Vancouver Coastal Health, Northern Health

**Q: What is considered “Proof of Vaccination” after September 26?**

**A:** Along with a government-issued photo ID, you will be

required to show your BC Vaccine Card.

**Q: How do I obtain a BC Vaccine Card?**

**A:** The Province's official vaccine card is now available digitally through the [health gateway website](#). A paper copy may also be obtained by contacting the **BC Services Centre support line at 1-833-838-2323** or visiting a **BC Services Centre**.

If there is any delay in the issuing of the official vaccine card, photo ID and the vaccination record provided at the time of immunization will be accepted until September 27. **After the 27th, only the official Provincial Vaccine Card will be accepted.**

**Q: How will Canlan Sports & Scotia Barn review my proof of vaccination?**

**A:** Before you enter our Sports Complex, you may provide your proof of vaccination to our Zone Control Attendants, beginning September 13.

**Q: Do I have to show my proof of vaccine every time I visit the sports complex?**

**A:** Yes, however, if you provide us consent to keep this information tied to your Canlan Sports registration, you won't need to provide the proof for future sessions.

**Q: Will I still need to wear a face mask and practice physical distancing if I show proof of vaccination?**

**A:** Yes, face masks will still be required in all common areas of the sports complex, including dressing rooms.

**Q: Do I need to wear a mask on the playing surface?**

**A:** No, you do not need to wear a mask while engaged in physical activity.

**We're all playing our part, so you can play normally again.**

As our rate of vaccinations increase, Canlan Sports and Scotia Barn will continue to prioritize our community and provide industry-leading protocols that put your health and safety first. Our building capacities

and classes sizes will remain reduced, and pre-registration will still be required for any drop-in activities on [canlansports.com](https://canlansports.com).
